



Job Description: Child Caregiver

Duties

The Child Caregiver is responsible to the Managing Director, and must:

- Provide care of the staff children during times when the staff are performing their duties (these times will be clearly defined during the first day of camp).
- Provide fun and stimulating activities for the children in your care. As the staff babysitter, it is your job to set out a schedule of activities each day and communicate this with parents. Activities may change each week, and will be dependent on a number of factors (age, weather, size of group).
- Ensure that the areas the children use are being taken care of while the children are playing and left in a tidy manner (you should get the children to help you with clean-up).
- Be enthusiastic – being a “staff kid” is often a child’s first experience at ABK. Make it one to remember!
- Depending on the schedule and the duties of their parents you may be asked to sit with the children during Chapel time if it is age appropriate.

When you get to camp, we will sit down with the staff members who have children, and we will arrange times you will be required to look after their children.

As the Child Caregiver, you will not:

- Be required to sit with children during meal times
- Change diapers
- Supervise swimming activities
