



# *Job Description:* *Counsellor*

## Duties

Counsellors are responsible to the Program Director(s), and must:

- Provide spiritual leadership in the cabin by loving campers with Christ's love, leading cabin devotions, and teaching Bible verses that are assigned.
- Establish a relationship with each camper that will enable you to have opportunity to share about Jesus' love.
- Work with your co-counsellor to control the behavior of your campers, and settle disputes when needed.
- Lead the activity you are assigned (canoeing, archery, sports, etc.)
- Ensure your cabin is kept clean
- Be enthusiastic
- Sit with your campers during Chapel time, and help them keep their attention focused on the Speaker.
- Supervise and control campers' behavior at meal times – **Meal time is not your time off!**
- Ensure your campers settle down quickly each evening
- Be responsible in what you post on social media throughout the year.

## Children

Due to the demanding nature of the Counsellor's role and the fact that you will be with your campers almost 24/7, we ask that counselors not bring children to camp with them, unless they are coming as campers.
