



Job Description: Head Server

Duties

The Head Server is responsible to the Kitchen Coordinator, and must:

- Oversee the work of the other servers, and ensure that all the server duties are performed each day
- Run the dishwasher (or appoint someone who is experienced to do it)
- Present yourself in a neat and clean manner
- Be in the Dining Hall 45 minutes prior to each meal to set the tables
- Wait on the tables throughout each meal
- Clean tables after each meal (clearing the food first and dishes second)
- Refill serviette/condiment containers as needed.
- Prepare juice/water so it is cold for meal time
- Serve the snack each evening, and clean up afterwards
- Head Servers are required to wear aprons. Hair must be pulled back, out of the face (hats or headscarves must be worn). Closed-toe shoes are required.
- Wash hands every time you enter the kitchen
- No open-toed shoes

Children

- Due to the nature of the Head Server position (working during meal times) we recommend not bringing staff children as our babysitters aren't on duty at meal times. If you would like to bring children please call Ryan at 705-94-1142.
