

Volunteer Policy (related to COVID-19)

Camp Aush-Bik-Koong has always relied heavily on volunteers to complete the work that needs to be done every summer. We care deeply for the health and safety of our volunteers. The following outlines Camp ABK's volunteer policy for 2020 based on recommendations from the Sudbury District Health Unit

Volunteer qualifications:

- All volunteers must be 16 years or older
- Prospective volunteers must contact Ryan by email at ryan@campabk.com. If accepted they will be given a specific time period in which they will volunteer and a specific task list.
- Volunteers will be screened prior to coming and required to self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 while at camp based on Health Unit recommendations
- Volunteers must bring their own mask with them in case physical distancing is not possible.
- Volunteers are expected to follow social distancing practices while at camp.

Accommodations

If the volunteer(s) is staying overnight they will be assigned one cabin per household. Volunteers are expected to clean all surfaces and bunks in their cabins with the disinfectant spray provided by camp when they leave.

Meals

Food will be provided by Camp

Meals will be served by a no-contact buffet and volunteers will be seated 2 square meters apart

Families

Normally we welcome the children of volunteers to ABK, but due to the physical distancing restrictions around COVID-19 we are unable to accommodate any volunteer staff kids this summer outside of our core summer staff families.
